

## Parking & Toilets

Information on the many car parks in the area private and local authority run, also blue badge area (disabled parking for free).

Toilets in the area, there are many around Lancaster and Morecambe but please note that a large number of them are becoming Pay to Use toilets, but still have disabled toilets operated with the RADAR key.

### On-Street Parking in Lancaster

Designated spaces for disabled drivers are to be found on the following streets:

- Bryen Street - 2 spaces.
- Top of Church Street - 3 spaces.
- Lower Cheapside - 2 spaces.
- Common Garden Street (side entrance M&S) - 3 spaces.
- Gage Street - 5 spaces.
- Back of City Museum (New Street) - 3 spaces.
- Quarry Road (back of Town Hall) - 2 spaces.

Blue badge holders may park on double yellow lines for up to 3 hours, providing they do not cause an obstruction.

Please do not block drop kerbs!

### Parking in Lancaster

Parking in these City Council car parks is free to Blue Badge holders.

- Bulk St - approximately 200m level route to city centre. Slope to Bulk St. Level exit to Nelson St.
- Dallas Rd - approximately 200m to city centre. No drop kerbs to city centre. Steep ramp to Fenton St.
- Damside St - small car park adjacent to Bus Station.
- Edward St - No drop kerbs to city centre. 250m level route.
- George St. - Small car park, 100m to City Centre.
- Nelson St. - Gravel surface, 150m to City Centre.
- St Leonardsgate - No drop kerbs to city centre. 200m to City Centre.
- Thurnham St. - 250 m to City Centre.
- St. Nicholas Arcade (enclosed car park). Entrance from Lower Church St. Lift access to St Nicholas Arcade and other shopping areas. Open Mon-Sat 08:00 - 18:00 hrs. Sun 09:00 - 17:00 hrs.

Please note the following car parks are privately owned & Blue Badges do not apply:

Marketgate car park, Open Mon-Sat 08:30 - 17:30 hrs

Park Safe car park, Mitre House (Entrance is from St Georges Quay). Open 24 hrs, 7 days a week. Tel:01524 581496.

**Parking restrictions in the Pedestrianized area:**

In Lancaster there is a parking permit scheme enabling car parking within the pedestrian area.

Between 10.30 and 4.30, Blue Badge holders with a Permit A, issued by the Council, may enter the Zone and park anywhere providing they are not causing an obstruction.

Prior to 10.30 and after 4.30, Blue badge holders (without Permit A) may enter the Zone and park in the designated bays situated in the Market Square and New St Square (behind the Museum).

This scheme is only available to residents, with permits being available from Lancaster Town Hall (Tel. 582000) and Lancaster Tourist Information Centre. You qualify for a Permit if you are aged 65 and over or exempt from car tax. Details of the Blue badge scheme are available from Social Services on 0845 053 0000

**Parking in Morecambe**

Morecambe has many car parks convenient to the seafront and town centre. Along the seafront are several City Council car parks which are free to Blue Badge holders, together with the Festival Market car park (10 designated spaces).

This car parking is close to the Visitor Information Centre, The Festival Market and Apollo cinema (see map).

The car park to the rear of the Winter Gardens is a privately owned park and disabled parking is NOT free, and has uneven surface.

**On Street Parking:**

- Market St (opposite Post Office) - several dedicated spaces.
- Marine Rd Central (by Midland Hotel).
- Marine Rd Central (opposite Clock Tower).
- Poulton Sq.
- Queen St - 1 dedicated space.
- Victoria St - 1 dedicated space.

## **Toilets**

There are many toilets located around Lancaster and Morecambe but please note that a large number of them are becoming Pay to Use toilets, but still have disabled toilets operated with the RADAR key.

The RADAR National Key Scheme ensures that one key will open all accessible toilets throughout the country.

RADAR keys can be purchased from Town Halls, Tourist Information Centres, and are also available from the One Voice for £2-£3 each.

- St Nicholas Arcade - next to lift at shop level.
- Marketgate - on ground floor next to lift.
- Bus station.
- Bulk St car park.

### MORECAMBE

- Festival Market Radar and Pay to use.
- Marine Rd Central Radar and Pay to use by clock tower.
- Marine Rd East opposite Happy Mount Park.
- Marine Rd West junction with Regent Rd.

### AROUND THE AREA

- Bare Promenade.
- Happy Mount Park.
- Bolton le Sands Community Centre.
- Crook of Lune Car Park, Caton.
- Market Square, Carnforth.
- Silverdale Gaskell Hall.
- Conder Green, Picnic Site.
- Many shops, supermarkets and cafes now have accessible toilets for the use of their customers.
